How It Works



Class II, Type A2 BSCs

Room air is drawn into the grille located in the air foil. The air in the area beneath the work surface is a mixture of unfiltered room air, and air that has just passed through the work area. This contaminated air is drawn by the blower through the back plenum of the cabinet, where approximately 70% of the air is recirculated through the supply HEPA filter and back over the work area. The balance of the contaminated air is discharged to the environment after passing through the exhaust HEPA filter.

Class II, Type B2 BSCs

Supply air enters the B2 from an inlet at the top of the cabinet and continues on flowing through the supply HEPA filter. Simultaneously, room air is drawn into the grille located in the air foil. The air in the area beneath the work surface is a mixture of unfiltered room air, and air that has just passed through the work area. This contaminated air is drawn by a remote blower connected to the B2 through exhaust ductwork. 100% of the air in this contaminated plenum is vented to the exterior of the building. Careful planning is required for B2 installations, whereas vented Type A2 and Type C1 cabinets provide substantial ease and safety.

The Type C1 BSC is the next generation BSC you've been waiting for. The first new BSC style in more than 25 years, the Type C1 is designed to flex and grow with you. This unique cabinet helps your lab adapt to whatever comes next, while providing safety and efficiency unavailable in

other cabinet types. The first and only cabinet that can switch between A Mode and B Mode, the Axiom Class II, Type C1 sets a new standard. NSF 49 approved, the Axiom provides a whole new experience in the same Labconco design you've grown accustomed to using.

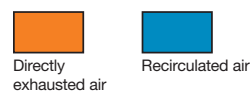
A mode

When operated in A Mode, room air is drawn into the inlet grille and directed below the plenum of the work surface where it mixes with air that has passed over the areas on either side of the Chem-Zone. This contaminated air mixture is drawn through the back plenum where it is recirculated through the supply HEPA filter and back over the work area. Air passing over the Chem-Zone is directed through the exhaust HEPA filter and returned to the room.



B mode

When operated in B Mode, 100% of the air passing over the Chem-Zone is directed through the exhaust HEPA filter and delivered to the ductwork where house exhaust can take over. Air passing over the areas on either side of the Chem-Zone is recirculated through the cabinet.

Flexibility

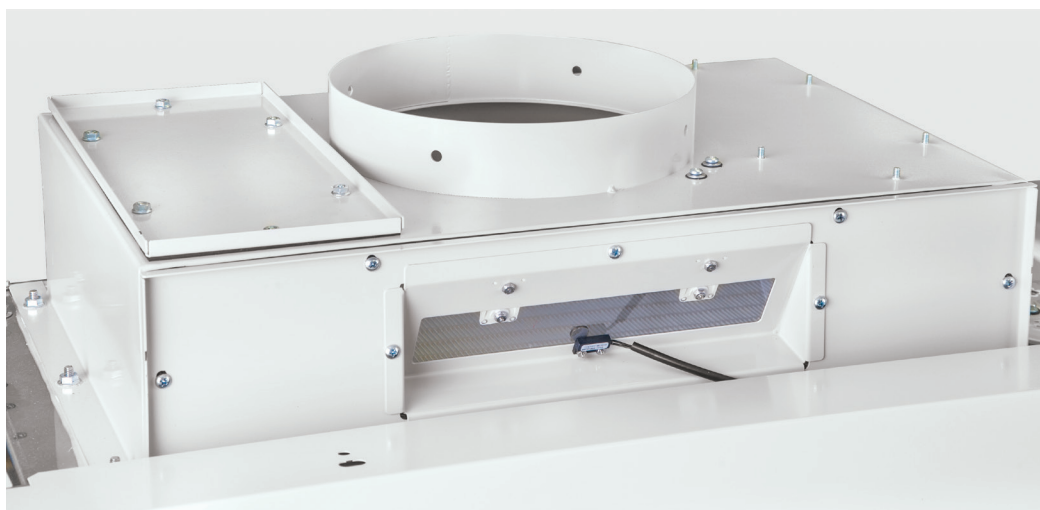
Omni-Flex™ Design

Unlike Type A2, B1 and B2 cabinets, the Axiom can adapt as needs change. Omni-Flex allows for installation in recirculating A Mode or in ducted B Mode for use with hazardous vapors. If your applications change, simply connect or disconnect the Axiom from exhaust.

The Axiom can be tied into almost any existing building ventilation system with sufficient exhaust reserve. Unlike B cabinets, no costly, dedicated remote blower and dedicated ductwork are required. The blower for a B1 or

B2 cabinet must be oversized to account for an increase of 4.0" w.g. or greater as the exhaust HEPA filter loads. Because the total exhaust area of the Axiom is limited to the Chem-Zone, exhaust air volume is reduced to ≈40% of a standard Class II, Type B1 or B2.

The Axiom's dedicated exhaust blower delivers air to the building exhaust at ≈0.3" w.g. throughout the life of the cabinet. The table below shows the reduced upfront installation cost compared to a Type B1 or B2.



To switch from B Mode to A Mode, disconnect the cabinet from the ductwork and move the plate from the left side of the exhaust collar to the right. Use the MyLogic Software to program the cabinet for A Mode and have the cabinet recertified. To switch from A Mode to B Mode, connect the cabinet to ductwork, move the plate from the right side to the left side, use the MyLogic Software to change the programming and have the cabinet recertified.

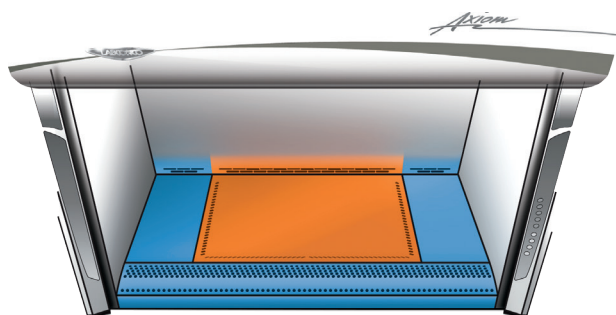

Chem-Zone™ Work Surface

The key to the Axiom® is its unique work surface. The surface consists of three pieces—the Chem-Zone dished center and two flat sides. The surface layout promotes the proper technique of organizing your work flow from clean to dirty. The Chem-Zone middle gives you ample room to perform your critical operations while containing spills. The ends function as storage for consumables and waste.



Shown in orange, the Chem-Zone is dished and delineated by airflow slots. Chem-Zone provides the primary working area for critical operator actions. The surfaces on either side of the Chem-Zone serve as staging areas.

When the Axiom is in A Mode, the filtered air is simply recirculated back into the lab. A Mode functions just as a Type A2 cabinet. When the Axiom is operated in B Mode, all chemical vapors and particulates generated from work in the Chem-Zone area are ensured a direct path to the exhaust filter, similar to how a B2 cabinet functions. One hundred percent of air is exhausted to the outside. Inflow air at the front grille and air from either side of the Chem-Zone are recirculated to save energy when operating in B Mode.

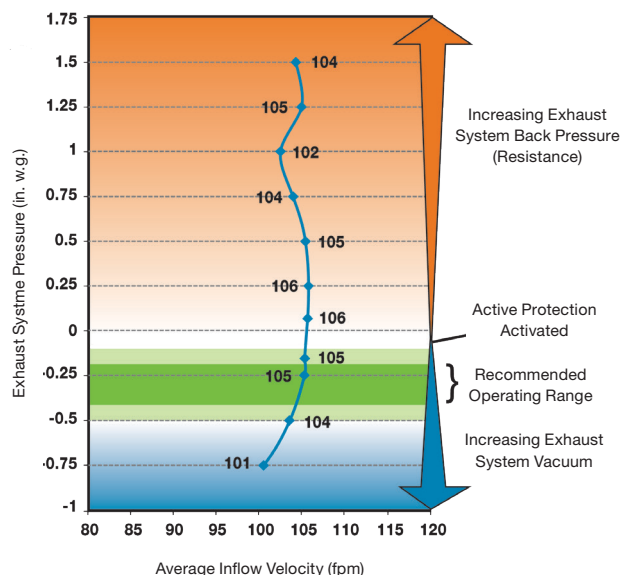
Active Protection Protocol (APP)

Provides an additional level of user safety only found on the Axiom Type C1 BSC. Designed to extend cabinet operation during building exhaust failure, APP utilizes the Axiom's dual intelligent CAP™ motors to keep the BSC running safely in the event of a building exhaust failure.

Should the building exhaust fail, the Axiom will begin Active Protection Protocol within 1 second. Safe airflows are maintained for up to five minutes, even with a completely dead remote exhaust blower. 4' Axiom models can exceed a static pressure of 1.5" w.g., which equates to 2,100' of straight 10" dia. duct. The 6' Axiom handles up to 1.0" w.g., which equates to 650' of straight 10" dia. duct.

Active Protection Protocol Inflows as Exhaust System Pressure Varies



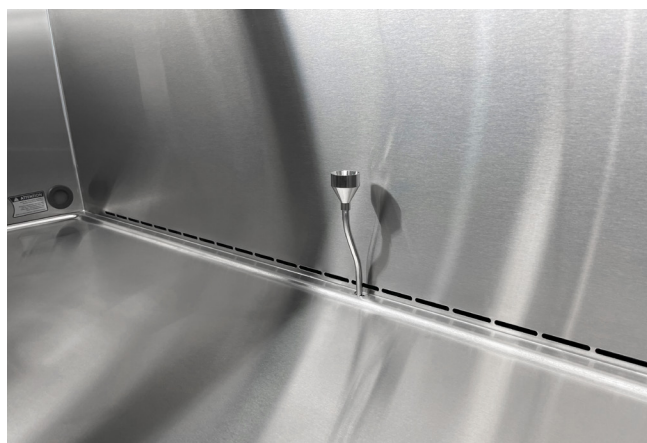
